Why do we have to invest in quality assurance (ANQA accreditation manual, 15-17 December 20110

- Does the HEI have a quality ethos, together with procedures that embed that ethos, throughout the institution and in the academic programme that is offers?
- Does the HEI systematically monitor its progress towards achieving an appropriate range of quality goals and in particular, further improving the quality of the educational provision?
- Are the findings from the quality assurance procedures used to improve the quality of the education and training provision and meet the needs of the learners?
- Does the HEI monitor the effectiveness of the services provided to the learner?
- Is corrective action taken to remedy deficiencies indentified by the quality assurance procedure?
- Is relevant information on institutional and academic programme quality given to stakeholders?

Are we doing the right things and are we doing this things good? Do the students learn the things they have learn? In a good way?
